А а	a	Sounds like english <b>A</b> in words - <b>ask, art, task, grass.</b>
Б б	b	Sounds like english <b>B</b> in words - <b>back, bad, ball.</b>
В в	v	Sounds like english <b>V</b> in words - <b>victory, very</b> – or like english <b>W</b> at end of words – <b>row, tow.</b>
Г г	h	Sounds like english <b>H</b> in words – <b>house, hat, hen.</b>
Ґ ґ	g	Sounds like english <b>G</b> in words - <b>game, get, gangster.</b>
Д д	d	Sounds like english <b>D</b> in words - <b>dark, day.</b>
Е е	e	Sounds like english <b>E</b> in words - <b>men, pent, best.</b>
Є є	je	Sounds like english <b>YE</b> in words - <b>yellow, yes, yesterday.</b>
Ж ж	zh	Sounds like english <b>S</b> in words - <b>treasure, measure.</b>
З з	z	Sounds like english <b>Z</b> in words - <b>zebra, zero, zoo.</b>
И и	y	Sounds like english very soundless <b>I</b> - in words <b>ink, mix, pick.</b>
І і	i	Sounds like english <b>EE</b> or <b>I</b> - in words <b>meeek, seen</b> or <b>pique, machine.</b>
Ї ї	ji	Sounds like english <b>YIE</b> - in word <b>yield</b> , or like <b>YEA</b> - in word <b>yeast.</b>
Й й	j	Sounds like english <b>Y</b> - in words <b>yes, yacht, boy.</b>
К к	k	Sounds like english <b>K</b> - in words <b>kite, kilo, kiss.</b>
Л л	l	Sounds like english <b>L</b> - in words <b>look, light lake.</b>
М м	m	Sounds like english <b>M</b> - in words <b>money, mother.</b>
Н н	n	Sounds like english <b>N</b> - in words <b>new, no, now.</b>
О о	o	Sounds like english <b>O</b> - in words <b>not, got, long.</b>
П п	p	Sounds like english <b>P</b> - in words <b>post, please, spot.</b>
Р р	r	Sounds like a “rolled” english <b>R</b> - in words <b>run, rest.</b>
С с	s	Sounds like english <b>S</b> - in words <b>sat, settle, sun.</b>
Т т	t	Sounds like english <b>T</b> - in words <b>test, table, wet.</b>

У у	u	Sounds between english <b>U</b> - in words <b>but, pull, full</b> , and english <b>OO</b> – in words <b>boot, pool, fool</b> .
Ф ф	f	Sounds like english <b>F</b> - in words <b>far, fat, fault</b> .
Х х	kh	Sounds like scottish <b>CH</b> - in word <b>loch</b> , but more voiced.
Ц ц	ts	Sounds like english <b>TS</b> - in words <b>tsetse, nuts</b> .
Ч ч	ch	Sounds like english <b>CH</b> - in words <b>chip, church, change</b> .
Ш ш	sh	Sounds like english <b>SH</b> - in words <b>shift, shoe, shoot</b> .
Щ щ	shch	Sounds like english <b>SHCH</b> - in words <b>fresh cheese</b>
Ю ю	ju	Sounds like english <b>YOU</b> - in word <b>you</b> .
Я я	ja	Sounds like english <b>YA</b> - in words <b>yard, yam, royal</b> .
Ь	'	This is not a letter, but a symbol. It makes a preceding consonant more tender (palatalized).
